For over 35 years the Finnish-American photographer Arno Minkkinen has primarily used his body in combination with the photographic medium to express surrealistic visions of man and nature. As professor for Art at the University of Massachusetts and as lecturer at the University of Art and Design in Helsinki Minkkinen has a long-standing reputation in teaching and transferring photographic issues. His work is published and exhibited worldwide.

“Establishing a direction in contemporary photography means more than having a good eye for the medium. It means selecting from hundreds of images those that best express your intentions as you build a body of work that not only enlightens others but also brings enlightenment and inspiration to you. In this workshop, we will seek to grow and expand your photographic talents not only as an image-maker but also as an artist with a contemporary vision of the world.” – A.M.

1st day:

Meeting at 10 a.m., Fotografie Forum Frankfurt, Weißfrauenstr. 1, 60311 Frankfurt. Arno Minkkinen will give an introduction. Individual portfolios will be reviewed and discussed. After handing out the assignments the participants will photograph in the afternoon until 5 p.m. exposed films and chip-cards of the day's work will be collected for overnight-development.

2nd day:

Meeting at 10 a.m. The photographs of the previous day will be discussed and edited.
